General

- It is illegal to dump garbage on City streets or public property.
- Clean up of garbage improperly set out for collection is the responsibility of the householder.

Recycling Depots

- In addition to curbside collection, residents may drop off recyclables at the Front St. at McIntyre St.; Mountdale Ave. at Walsh St.; or Thunder Bay Solid Waste and Recycling Facility depots.
- Hours of operation: Monday to Saturday, 8 am-6:30 pm. Closed Sundays and Statutory Holidays except for the Thunder Bay Solid Waste & Recycling Facility Depot which is open during regular Landfill Site hours of operation.

- Vehicles are charged based on weight of load. The charge for less than 125 kg (275 lbs) is \$6.
- Loads must be secured and covered.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

One Can Make a Difference

Place sorted recyclables in see-through plastic bags. Place sorted recycling bags 1.5 metres (5 feet) away from your garbage at the curb. **No bag limit. Maximum bag weight is 18kg (40 lbs).**

(Bag 1) Containers

- glass, metal food & beverage containers
- pop cans
- clean aluminum foil containers
- No. 1 & 2 plastic bottles with small necks and twist off tops
- Tetra Paks & milk cartons

(Bag 2) Paper

- newspapers, flyers, magazines, catalogues and soft cover books
- household fine paper
- paper egg cartons
- boxboard boxes (eg. cereal)

Gift Wrap is **NOT** recyclable

Cardboard

- cardboard in bundles
90 cm x 60 cm x 30 cm
(3 ft x 2 ft x 1 ft) broken down flat & tied with string or rope
- clean pizza boxes

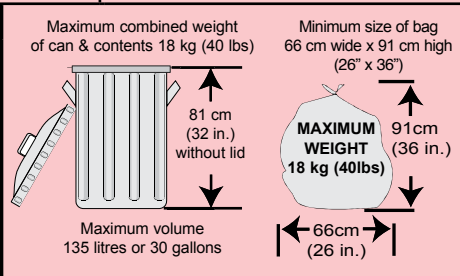

Garbage Collection	Container By-law Requirements	Not Acceptable
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Garbage must be at the curb on collection day before 7 am or after 4 pm the day before collection. Place garbage and recyclables a few metres apart at the curb if possible. Maximum three items. Safely wrap broken glass or sharp objects. Animal waste should be sealed, wrapped and double bagged, and placed in with your regular garbage. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Maximum weight 18 kg (40 lbs) per item. Maximum three items per collection. Garbage Containers: durable plastic or metal with proper handles. Lid must be tight fitting but easily removable (<i>not tied or secured to can in any way</i>). Garbage bags must be 1.5 mm thick. Do NOT use see-through plastic bags for garbage (<i>black or green bags only</i>). Tie bags securely to prevent spillage. Do not use cardboard boxes as waste containers. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Liquid waste. Construction waste such as plaster. Cardboard – recycle at curb. Needles, medical sharps, etc. Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) – bring to the Landfill Site HHW Depot during regular Landfill Site operating hours only.

Collection Safety Tips

- Do not dispose of needles, medical sharps etc. in regular garbage – for information on safe disposal, **contact 684-2195**.
- Place garbage items at ground level - never on snow banks.



Leaf & Yard Waste Collection

- Each spring and fall, leaves, bundled branches and garden waste are collected at the curb. Find the leaf symbol on your calendar for your collection day.
- Use clear plastic or Kraft (paper) bags ONLY for leaf and yard waste (no grass clippings). No bag limit.
- Leaf and yard waste can be recycled year-round at the Landfill Site in the compost area.
- Bundle branches or brush less than 1 metre (39 in.) long, and less than 61 cm (24 in.) in diameter, using string or rope.
